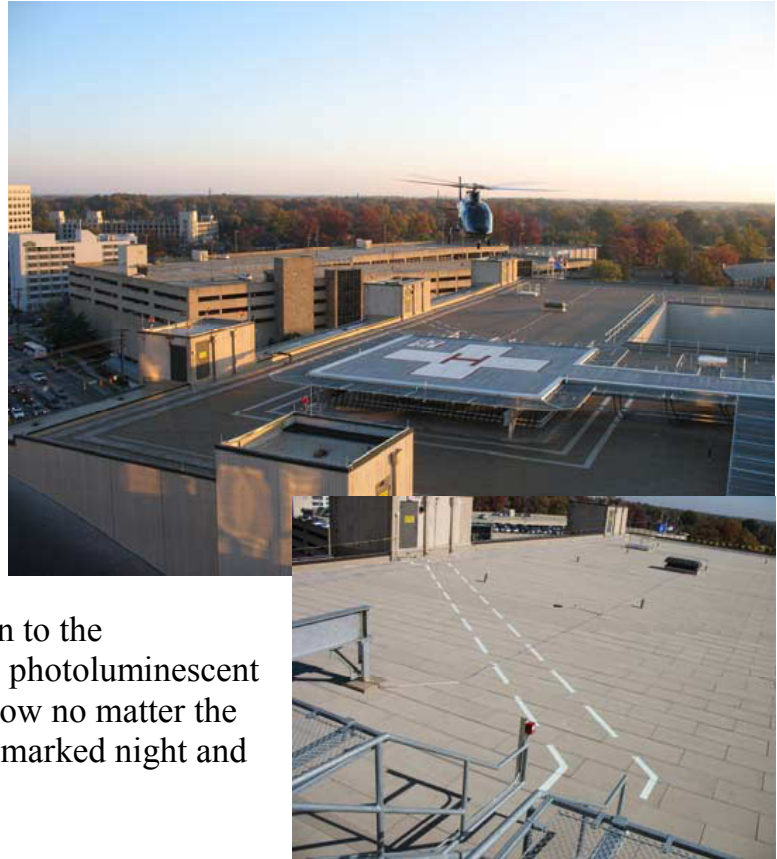




Duke University Helipad

When installing the helipad on the roof of the Duke University Medical Center the emergency exits on the roof of the structure were far from the helipad. In the case of an accident which may cause a power loss, finding the roof top stairwell entrances would be difficult, potentially posing a great danger to the roof top occupants attempting to flee a hazardous situation. So in addition to the emergency lights we used Jalite's photoluminescent solvent free epoxy –Jalite SFE. Now no matter the circumstances our exits paths are marked night and day.
